2015/16 NATIONAL HIGHPOINT SHOW HUNTER: PONY, GALLOWAY, HORSE OF THE YEAR

2015/16 STATE HIGHPOINT: AHHA MEMBERS & SHOW HUNTER/S OF THE YEAR

AHHA MEMBERS SHOW HUNTER HIGHPOINT COMPETITION WILL RUN FROM:

The 1st of August 2015 until the 31st July 2016.

MEMBERSHIP with the Australian Hunter Horse Association must be current for points to count.

Members can enter more than 1 horse in the competition. However each horse must be entered on a separate highpoint entry form and will have their own individual results sheets.

ENTRIES

- Entry Fee is **\$10.00** per horse/rider combination
- ENTRY FEES will jackpot towards the overall prizemoney to be won. More members that enter will result in a larger amount of prizemoney. Encourage the people that you show hunters against to also enter.
- **DOWNLOAD AND COMPLETE THE HIGHPOINT ENTRY FORM** from the AHHA website . You may post OR scan and email your entry form through to australianhunterhorses@gmail.com
- Entry fee can be paid by direct bank transfer or by cheque (details are on the entry form)
- **SEND COMPLETED ENTRY FORM BY POST OR EMAIL** to the AHHA (details on the entry form) Please contact AHHA should you have any questions or need further info on australianhunterhorses@gmail.com

OFFICIAL RESULTS SHEETS

- 2 official results sheets per entry will be forwarded to you by post. Members to record their horses wins and placings on the results sheet.
- Only official results sheets will be accepted to qualify for the highpoint competition.

RECORDING RESULTS:

- It is the responsibility of the AHHA Member to correctly record results & show information.
- Members will fill out their own results sheets. No requirement to have judge/steward/show society to sign. Results will be verified by the AHHA secretary.
- Results sheets can be sent in as completed, during the year or by the end of August 2016.
- Winners will be announced on the AHHA website & facebook and will be presented their prizes at a major show within reasonable travelling distance of their home town.

QUALIFYING SHOWS:

- All agricultural shows in all states of Australia –NSW, Vic, Tas, SA, WA, NT, Qld
- Other open shows can become points qualifiers by an AHHA member contacting AHHA to nominate the show for acceptance.
- Show details including a contact phone number/website address & program will need to be provided.
- Once the nominated show is approved it will be listed in the AHHA website calendar of events.

POINTS:

- Points will be awarded for 1st to 6th place, champion & reserves
- Points will be awarded for ridden classes only
- AHHA members/registered, child's, adults/ladies/gents and any open height class are eligible.
- Novice, Intermediate, Newcomer, District, Local, Led, Working Hunter classes not eligible this year.
- The Highpoint competition will take into account the number of shows eligible for points within a members' reasonable travelling distance in each state and home area, when finalizing the results for highpoint winners.

YOUTH CATEGORY: Age of rider is under 17yrs. Rider must be a member. Horse must be owned by the rider or Parent.

AMATEUR CATEGORY: Members can enter the youth or adult category as well as the amateur - providing that the rider is the owner of the show hunter and is an AHHA Member, and has never: Ridden, Trained or Shown a Horse for any form of payment, or shown a horse in a professional manner on behalf of another owner without payment.

PRIZES:

Special Sash, Embroidered rug, Embroidered Polo Shirt, Certificate, Prize Product, Prizemoney.
